HOW TO APPLY

Applications open in October for our primary and secondary teacher training course places, which start each September. Applications are submitted through one of two portals - UCAS teacher training www.ucas.com or the Department for Education Apply www.gov.uk/apply-for-teacher-training.


We are looking for ambitious graduates or career changers (with a degree) who are passionate and enthusiastic about their subject and who have a strong desire to share this with young people of all abilities. You also need at least a Grade C/Grade 4 in GCSE English and maths, and a Grade C/Grade 4 or above in GCSE science for primary school training. Applicants with relevant industrial or commercial experience are also very welcome to apply.

With the expertise of *MERIT*, we are committed to ensuring that applicants from minority backgrounds are supported in fair access during the application and selection process. *MERIT* provides support mechanisms to guide BME candidates wishing to train as a teacher.
